Activity 4: Passport to Safety 101

Passport to Safety offers several online health and safety tests, designed to ensure that individuals have the basic health and safety awareness necessary as a foundation for job-specific training. There is a general test suitable for the adult population, along with a teen challenge test, a supervisor assessment test and a basic test called Passport to Safety 101, which would be the most appropriate for Grade 8 students. When they successfully complete the test (everyone must get 100% to pass) students are able to print a certificate to acknowledge their basic awareness of safety. The certificate can become part of their portfolio when they're volunteering or applying for a job.

Getting started
